


How to create an Alert

What is an Alert?

- An Alert is a search that is saved in a database(s).
- It is used to search for new content when the database(s) is updated. (PsycINFO is updated on a weekly basis.)
- You can receive your Alert via email or RSS.
- An Alert remains in effect for six months, but you can continue it for a longer period of time.

1. Do your Search

Below is an example of an **Advanced Search** with the descriptors **face perception** and **infant development** (Use the online thesaurus to identify descriptors.) Click *Search*.
