Other Activity

Change to Supplemental Professional Development Funds Call

Every year a significant amount of unspent Supplemental Professional Development money is returned to the library bottom line. In an effort to curb this, the committee undertook a major change to the call for Supplemental Professional Development funds. This year, 2 calls were issued, one in late fall and the other in spring. Over all, it seems that fewer people opted in and that the unspent funds this year were a result of genuinely unforeseen changes in need. The committee will continue to issue 2 calls next year for further assessment.

Policy for Course Support

The committee had a request for course support that prompted discussion about how decisions are made about what to support and when. The committee drafted a loose policy outlining when course registrations would be sponsored and specifically indicating that training funds should be sought first.

Preparation for coming year

- In order to re-balance the number of members rotating off each year, the committee will need to allow some members to stay on for more than 2 years. A request was submitted to Exec and will need to be approved in FY2020
- The committee identified inconsistencies in grant reporting and application requirements between local and statewide. Changes were submitted to Exec at the end of FY2019 and will hopefully be approved during FY2020
