### PURCHASE AND CONTENT LICENSING AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into as of the date set forth below (the "Effective Date") by and between Oxford University Press, Inc., [REDACTED] non-profit corporation with offices at [REDACTED] "Oxford") and the entity or person set forth below ("Licensee").

#### I. DEFINITIONS

- (a) "Licensed Works" means the Oxford electronic titles purchased by the Licensee as specifically set forth in the attached Schedule of Titles or as subsequently purchased under this agreement and set forth on additional Schedules and incorporated by reference.
- (b) "Authorized Users" means individuals who are authorized by the Licensee to access the Licensee's information services available through a secure network and who are (i) affiliated with the Licensee as current students, faculty, library patrons, employees, or in some other capacity whereby they are permitted to access such services in the Licensee's ordinary course of business, or (ii) are physically present on the Licensee's premises.
- (c) "Commercial Use" shall mean use of the Licensed Works for the purposes of monetary reward (whether by or for the Subscriber, an Authorized User, or any other person or entity) by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire, or other form of exploitation; provided, however, that neither recovery of direct costs by the Licensee from its Authorized Users, nor use by the Licensee or by an Authorized User in the course of research that incidentally uses Licensed Works and that is funded by a commercial organization shall be deemed to be Commercial Use.
- (d) "Course Packs" shall mean collections or compilations of printed materials (e.g., entries, articles) assembled by faculty or staff of the Licensee, if the Licensee is an educational institution, for use by students in connection with a specific course of instruction offered by the Licensee to its students.
- (e) "Electronic Reserves" shall mean electronic copies of materials (e.g., entries, articles from the Licensed Works) made and stored on the Secure Network by the Licensee, if the Licensee is an educational institution, for use by students in connection with a specific course of instruction offered by the Licensee to its students.
- (f) "Fair Use" shall mean use by the Licensee or an Authorized User (i) conforming to Sections 107 and 108 of the Copyright Revision Act 1976 as those provisions have been amended and may be amended from time to time, or (ii) conforming to the guidelines developed by the National Commission on New Technological Uses of Copyrighted Works ("CONTU Guidelines").
- (g) "Secure Network" shall mean a network (whether a stand alone network or a virtual network within the Internet) which is only accessible to Authorized Users whose identities are authenticated at the time of login and periodically thereafter, consistent with current best practices, and whose conduct is subject to regulation by the Licensee.

#### 2. LICENSE

The Licensee is granted a nonexclusive and non-transferable license to use and allow access to the Licensed Works by Authorized Users via a Secure Network. The Use of the Licensed Works shall be for personal, educational, and research purposes. If the Licensee is an educational institution, it may incorporate portions of the Licensed Works into printed Course packs and Electronic Reserves Collections

for use by Authorized Users in a course of instruction at the Licensee's educational institution, but not for Commercial Use. Each portion of the Licensed Works used in this manner shall be identified with an appropriate acknowledgement of the source, listing the title and author of the extract, title and author of the work, and "Oxford University Press" as the publisher. Copies of such extracts shall be deleted by the Licensee or Authorized User when the extracts are no longer being used in the course of instruction. Course Packs in non-print forms, such as audio or Braille, may also be offered to Authorized Users who, in the reasonable belief of the Licensee, are visually impaired.

### 3. LIMITATIONS ON USE OF THE LICENSED WORKS

The Licensee and Authorized Users may not:

- (a) Make electronic copies of the Licensed Works, except to load the original files onto the Secure Network when self-hosting;
- (b) Remove or alter the author's names or Oxford's copyright notices or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Works;
- (c) Systematically make printed or electronic copies of multiple extracts of the Licensed Works for any purpose, except to the limited extent expressly permitted above.
- (d) Display or distribute any part of the Licensed Works on any electronic network, including, without limitation, the Internet and the World Wide Web, other than a Secure Network.
- (e) Permit anyone other than Authorized Users to access or use the Licensed Works.
- (f) Use all or any part of the Licensed Works for any Commercial Use.
- (g) Publish, distribute, or make available works based upon the Licensed Works, or works which combine the Licensed Works with any other material, except to the limited extent expressly permitted by this agreement; or
- (h) Alter, abridge, adapt, or modify Licensed Works, except to the extent necessary to make them perceptible on a computer screen to Authorized Users.

Nothing in the Agreement shall limit the rights of the Licensee or an Authorized User to make a Fair Use of the Licensed Works. The Licensee shall use reasonable efforts to protect the Licensed Works from any use that is not permitted under this Agreement, and shall notify Oxford of any such use of which it becomes aware.

In the event that either party believes that the other materially has breached any obligations under this Agreement, or if Oxford believes that Licensee has exceeded the scope of the License, such party shall so notify the breaching party in writing. The breaching party shall have sixty (60) days from the receipt of notice to cure the alleged breach and to notify the non-breaching party in writing that cure has been effected. If the breach is not cured within the sixty (60) day period, the non-breaching party shall have the right to terminate the Agreement without further notice.

Licensee shall use reasonable efforts to protect the Licensed Materials from any use that is not permitted under this Agreement. In the event of any unauthorized use of the Licensed Materials by an Authorized User, (a) Oxford may terminate such Authorized User's access to the Licensed Materials, (b) Oxford may terminate the access of the Internet Protocol ("IP") address(es) from which such unauthorized use occurred, and/or (c) Licensee shall terminate such Authorized User's access to the Licensed Materials upon Oxford's request. Oxford shall take none of the steps described in this paragraph without first providing a sixty (60) day notice to Licensee and cooperation with the Licensee to avoid recurrence of any unauthorized use.

### 4. HOSTING

The Licensed Works will, at the option of the Licensee, either be (i) delivered to the Licensee in electronic files for the Licensee to host or (ii) purchased with hosting services from Oxford for the Licensed Works. The Licensee may elect to terminate hosting services at the end of the agreed term and Oxford will provide the electronic files for all Licensed Works purchased.

### 6. LIMITED WARRANTY

- (a) **Warrantee:** Subject to the Limitations set forth elsewhere in this Agreement: Oxford warrants that it has the right to license the rights granted under this Agreement to use Licensed Materials, that it has obtained any and all necessary permissions from third parties to license the Licensed Materials, and that use of the Licensed Materials by Authorized Users in accordance with the terms of this Agreement shall not infringe the copyright of any third party. Oxford warrants that the physical medium, if any, on which the Licensed Materials is provided to Licensee will be free from defects for a period of ninety (90) days from delivery.
- (b) **Limitations on Warranties:** Notwithstanding anything else in this Agreement: Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, punitive or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of data, business interruption, or loss of profits, arising out of the use of or the inability to use the Licensed Materials. Oxford makes no representation or warranty, and expressly disclaims any liability with respect to the content of any Licensed Materials, including but not limited to errors or omissions contained therein, libel, infringement of rights of publicity, privacy, trademark rights, moral rights, or the disclosure of confidential information. Except for the express warranties stated herein, the Licensed Materials are provided on an "as is" basis, and Oxford disclaims any and all other warranties, conditions, or representations (express, implied, oral or written), relating to the Licensed Materials or any part thereof, including, without limitation, any and all implied warranties of quality, performance, merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Oxford makes no warranties respecting any harm that may be caused by the transmission of a computer virus, worm, time bomb, logic bomb or other such computer program. Oxford further expressly disclaims any warranty or representation to Authorized Users, or to any third party.
- (c) **Indemnities:** The Oxford shall indemnify and hold Licensee and Authorized Users harmless for any losses, claims, damages, awards, penalties, or injuries incurred, including reasonable attorney's fees, which arise from any claim by any third party of an alleged infringement of copyright or any other property right arising out of the use of the Licensed Materials by the Licensee or any Authorized User. **NO LIMITATION OF LIABILITY SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS AGREEMENT IS APPLICABLE TO THIS INDEMNIFICATION.** Each party shall indemnify and hold the other harmless for any losses, claims, damages, awards, penalties, or injuries incurred, including reasonable attorney's fees, which arise from any alleged breach of such indemnifying party's representations and warranties made under this Agreement, provided that the indemnifying party is promptly notified of any such claims.
- (d) Neither party shall be liable to the other for any loss or damage attributable to, and neither party shall be deemed to be in default hereunder as a result of, any failure or delay in performance caused by force majeure. For purposes of this Agreement, the term "force majeure" shall include strike, lockout, earthquake, hurricane, flood, fire, or other acts of God or nature, war, rebellion, civil disorders, laws, regulations, acts of civil or military authorities (including the denial or cancellation of any export or other necessary license), unavailability of materials, carriers, or communications facilities, and any other causes beyond the reasonable control of the party whose performance is affected. Both parties shall use all reasonable efforts to minimize the consequences of force majeure.
- (e) Oxford makes no warranties respecting any harm that may be caused by the inadvertent transmission of any computer virus, worm, time bomb, logic bomb, or other such computer program transmitted with the Licensed Materials.

### 7. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed according to, and governed by, the laws of the state of California.

### 8. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This is a recording of the entire Agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior communications, understandings, and agreements, oral or written.
