They were collected by a group of 17 Kirkland women who are regular Dominion customers (some living only a few blocks from the store) as a protest against your company's policy.

As consumers we are in sympathy with the farm workers in California and support the present grape boycott as their only means of protest against their living and working conditions. The only assistance we are able to offer these workers is by our continuing to shop at stores that do support the boycott...as you can see, this will mean a considerable loss of revenue to your company.

Previously we have all been satisfied Dominion customers, and have always found the local Manager and his staff most pleasabt and helpful. This is not a complaint against them, but against Dominion's overall Head Office policy.

We hope this letter will encourage you to reconsider your decision in this matter.
