

Chavez Pact in Cleveland

CLEVELAND, Aug. 8 (AP)— Cesar Chavez, leader of the striking California grape pickers, witnessed today the signing of an agreement whereby local supermarkets will place signs in their stores urging shoppers to support the strikers and not buy California grapes. The agreement between the Cleveland Food Industry Committee, the United Farm Workers Organizing Committee and the Cleveland Federation of Labor was signed in Mayor Carl B. Stokes' office.
