U. F. W. Wins Lettuce Ranch

SALINAS, Calif. Sep. 10 (AP)
—Cesar Chavez's United Farm
Workers scored a major victory
today in the battle with the
teamsters to represent farm
workers, winning an election at
InterHarvest, the nation's biggest lettuce ranch.

The count was 1,167 for the U.F.W. and 28 for the teamsters, state officials said. There were also 18 votes for no union. The victory at InterHarvest, where the U.F.W. has had a contract since 1970, had been expected.
