This scriv: to Inform: I am. Elated be God, after the
fatigues of a thousand journeys of 9 weeks safe arrived at a
my desired port, in good health. Elated be Almighty God for
the same, & take this opportunity by J: Beccal, who is just a
going to our Island. I having bin a shor but two days, can't
write y: any news private or publick, but by y: next shall be
more full. I have not as yet bin at Bath, but designe thither
God willing in a day or two, I find Shugars to be a better commodity
then I expected, but money & credit as scarce here as in our
Island, & nothing to had without a penny, therefore hope y: generally
can't ship me somonore thenged by y: first Safo hand, pay
as soon as either or course provided they be dry, the grain, & jury
Consign them to M^r John Baker Junr.

I pray me Commanded to all friends & neighbours, particularly
good Mad^r Blby Co; w^t concludes me, to: Gloucester City
our Servts, & tenderest love to J: Self, w^t hearty prayers to
almighty God for J: Healths & Welfare
