Stone says he will pay your Son Thomases Legacy next from - would it be agreeable to lend it to Juliares Herring for a Couple of years whom very good Security he is a most industria man gwants to build a Water Work but cannot do it gmake his other payments let me know your mind on this matter an not at all satisfied with the present made of letting out your Whas since I have been over you have lost three Myrocs some by sicident & some by being neglected when clock 8 the Repairs above \$100 so that It doth not appear to me you not any thing by it I have therefore let Mr Chiland home that I will rent it for the time to come without Regroes & given him a Month to provider of its he lives mostly in the Mondains

where he is settling a Sugar Work, so that the Whas fis flighly under the face of his Brother John & another Boy of Sam affraid This new Selllen and M. Muse's Debt will hurt that Family Isam pays more regard to his own opinion than any others, I have been round your Estates of The new Estates look whening well The oto ones have suffered by the dry weather, If the Jeasons that have been for a fortnight past continue I hope the fames will entirely recover, & make more than last frop as These are good plants in the Ground, but really if the dry weather had continued I or 3 weeks longer most of the Platon would been intirely dead There are 3 flunch!
