Dear Son

27 August / Monday fore
noon

Your Father was taken with the Gout last
Friday w^{ch} has bin very severe and fear it will
continue so for some time He was not able to
resyrine any thing about His business in Town
till this Day, and as it is impossible He can
goe to Town Himself, has got Mr Bowen
to goe with instructions about the affair
and He sets out this after noon

If you could spare time to come over here, I
would be very glad to see you, as well as your
Father, my Neighbours at Gloues Cove are
goeing to survey these Lands there, and as I
apprehend I have a good Deal of Surplus
Land within my bounds, fear if I have
not a person of some Judgement to survey
mine shall loose a great part of it

Your ^{Father} desire me to tell ^{you} He can think of nothing,
He is in such pain, and desires you order every
thing at Gloues as you think proper, I fear this
fit of the Gout is owing to the bad situation of
His affairs which makes me very uneasy
but as I hope to see you soon shall say no
more about it, my kind love and blessing
tend you & yours, your Father desires His
I am Dear Son — Your most affectionate Mother

I understand you are to receive Mary Hulls
some money for Mr Pelin pray put Him in Mind
to send Mr Dunger fords Money, over as He has askt
me to get it for Him, & He Cred: Mr Pelin on my account
