We hope the present may find you & your family safely arrived in England, and we have the pleasure to communicate to you that the Case your letter into and containing Prints & Sundries has been shipped at Leghorn to the address of Messrs Fullers to whom we have by this day's post transmitted the Bill of Lading

Having paid certain Sums on your account and incurred the Expense of Shipment both here and at Leghorn as for the above at post, we this day reimburse ourselves on your account Bankers in £55. 13. 9 which we have no doubt you have authorized them to honor. Nothing new as yet respecting any loss of the Copyings.
