Description: The accession consists of 14 scrapbook volumes comprised of newspaper clippings from Sam D. Hinton's column, The Ocean World, published weekly on Sundays in the San Diego Union from July 27, 1958 to February 16, 1986. The column was started by Sam Hinton when he was Curator of the Aquarium-Museum at Scripps Institution of Oceanography. The scrapbooks were compiled by Leslie Hinton (Mrs. Sam D. Hinton) for her husband. Each scrapbook is numbered and dated. Each clipping is brief and small, generally measuring 4x6 inches or less. Some clippings are missing.

The column documents common ocean life and consists of an original drawing by Sam Hinton and descriptive text including the common and scientific name of each creature, its size and a brief description of the creature. The features document marine mammals, birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles, invertebrates, marine insects, marine plants and microorganisms.

Reproduction formats: The original drawings and text for the column was sent by Sam Hinton weekly to the San Diego Union for publication. The originals were returned by the San Diego Union to Sam Hinton who donated them to Scripps Archives. This collection is the newspaper clippings themselves, and not Hinton's original drawings. Hinton mailed his drawings to the San Diego Union, who used them and returned them to Hinton. The original drawings are in accession 2006-54, and their copyright was held by Hinton, who gifted them to UC Regents. Copyright for original artwork held by UC Regents
