Description: The accession includes autobiographical and biographical material, correspondence, original drawings, manuscripts of publications, and teaching files of Sam Duffie Hinton. While the accession largely documents Hinton's career as a biologist and naturalist at Scripps Institution of Oceanography and the University of California, San Diego, a few items in the collection document his career as a folksinger. The drawings include many original drawings, cartoons and illustrations by Sam Hinton during his years as an illustrator at the University of California Division of War Research during World War II, drawings of ocean life, scientific drawings and a few drawings related to music. The publications include original manuscripts, reprints, and drafts of scientific papers, and several memoirs including his autobiography, A Naturalist in Show Business. The accession includes correspondence with UC Press, drafts and other papers documenting Hinton's book Seashore Life of Southern California (1st edition, 1969; 2nd edition, 1987). The accession includes Hinton's card index to his syndicated San Diego Union Tribune column, The Ocean World. The teaching files include class schedules, teaching notes, and slides largely used for Sam Hinton's University Extension courses in biology and oceanography during the period 1964-1982. The slides include images of the sea shore, ocean life, and natural history of California. There are slides of Anza-Borrego Desert in April 1971, Carmel Valley in June 1971, Joshua Tree National Monument in 1973, and slides taken before 1976 for a slide tour of UCSD.
