Reid served as secretary for NORPAC. The collection includes some material documenting Equapac, a 1956-1966 international oceanographic expedition in the waters of the South Pacific. The accession includes three films of expeditions. Two of these are identified as original films taken on Boreas, which was a leg of Scripps Institution of Oceanography Zetes Expedition, January to August 1966.
