PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: 18 film negatives

DESCRIPTION: Film negatives of dives made in diving saucer, associated with Jacques Cousteau. Subjects include Carl Hubbs, Earl Murray, Richard Rosenblatt, Douglas Inman, Edward Winterer, and Francis Shepard. Dive numbers are 287, 290, 300-302, 312, 331, 336, 337, 348, and 353, from January 25, 1965 – April 28, 1965. Film transferred from Hollywood Film Enterprises vault by HFE's Neil Hamilton, who speculated the HFE had made prints for SIO from these negatives, and had not returned the negatives. Correspondence and a list of dives giving dive location, date, observer, etc., can be found in the Subject Files (81-16) under "Ships - Diving Saucer Correspondence, 1963-1966."
