**THIS** Electronic Products License Agreement (herein referred to as "LICENSE" is agreed the 23rd of October, 2019.

#### **BETWEEN**

Iter (herein referred to as the "Licensor")

University of California, San Diego (herein referred to as the "Licensee")

WHEREAS the Licensor holds the rights granted under this License,

AND WHEREAS the Licensee desires to use the Licensed Materials and the Licensor desires to grant to the Licensee the license to use the Licensed Materials for the Purchase Fee, subject to the terms and conditions of this License.

#### IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

#### 1. **DEFINITIONS**

In this License, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

#### 1.1. Authorized Users.

Full and part time students, current employees and faculty (including permanent, temporary, contract or visiting appointments) and researchers associated with the Licensee, regardless of the physical location of such persons. Walk-in Users shall be deemed to be Authorized Users under the terms and conditions of this License.

#### 1.2. Commercial Use.

Use of the Licensed Materials for the purposes of monetary reward (whether by the Licensee, or Authorized Users or Walk-in Users) by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of commerce. For the avoidance of doubt, the following uses shall not be deemed to

constitute Commercial Use: use of the Licensed Materials by Authorized Users in the course of research funded by commercial organizations; recovery of direct costs by the Licensee from Authorized Users of the Licensed Materials in the course of research funded by a commercial organization; the payment of an administrative fee by a person in order to be registered with the Licensee as a Walk-in User; the recovery of copying costs as outlined in Section 3.5.

#### 1.3. Course Packs.

A collection or compilation of materials (e.g. book chapters) assembled by staff of the Licensee for use by students in a class for the purposes of instruction.

# 1.4. Electronic Reserves.

Electronic copies of materials (e.g. book chapters) made and stored on the Secure Network by the Licensee for use by students who are Authorized Users in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by the Licensee to its students.

# 1.5. Purchase Fee.

The one-time payment set out in Schedule 1 for perpetual access to the Licensed Materials set forth on the initial Schedule 1 to this License. In the event additional Schedules of Licensed Materials are added to this License an additional Purchase Fee shall be payable by the Licensee as agreed by the parties. For the avoidance of doubt, the Purchase Fee shall be exclusive of any sales tax, and the Licensee shall be liable for any such taxes in addition to the Purchase Fee.

#### 1.6. Licensed Materials.

The electronic material as set out in Schedule 1 or in new Schedules to this License that may be agreed by the parties from time to time.

#### 1.7. Premises.

The physical premises of the Library or Libraries operated by the Licensee.

# 1.8. Secure Network.

A network which is only accessible to Authorised Users.

#### 1.9. Server.

The server, either the Licensor's server or a third party server designated by the Licensor, on which the Licensed Materials are mounted and may be accessed.

# 1.10. Walk-in Users.

Individuals not affiliated with Licensee who are physically present at Licensee's site(s) are granted access to the Licensed Materials subject to the terms of this License.

# 2. GRANT OF LICENSE

## 2.1. General.

The Licensor has obtained the right to provide the Licensed Materials from the publishers of the materials contained in the databases.

Licensor hereby grants to the Licensee the nonexclusive and non-transferable right, to permit Authorized Users to access the Licensed Materials via a Secure Network and using the access methods specified in Schedule 1 for the purposes of personal research, teaching, private study, and administrative use associated with the normal practices and activities of the Licensee consistent with the fair dealing principles of Canadian copyright law and comparable principles of international copyright law, subject to the terms and conditions of this License.

Except for the rights expressly granted under this License, all other rights are reserved to and shall remain the exclusive property of Licensor.

# 2.2. Perpetual Access.

Licensor hereby grants to Licensee a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use the Licensed Materials that were accessible during the term of this License. Such use shall be in accordance with the provisions of this License, which provisions shall survive any termination of this License.

### 3. USAGE RIGHTS

Nothing in this License shall in any way limit the ability of the Licensee's Authorized Users to engage in or conduct any activity that would not constitute an infringement under Canadian or any other copyright laws, in respect of a copyrighted work.

The Licensed Materials may be used for the purposes of research, education, distance learning, or other non-commercial use as follows:

# 3.1. Display.

The Licensee and Authorized Users shall have the right to electronically display the Licensed Materials.

# 3.2. <u>Digitally Copy.</u>

The Licensee and Authorized Users may download and digitally copy a reasonable limited portion of the Licensed Materials.

# 3.3. Saving Copy

The Licensee and Authorized Users may electronically save reasonable limited portions of the Licensed Materials.

# 3.4. Print Copy.

The Licensee and Authorized Users may print a reasonable limited portion of the Licensed Materials.

## 3.5. Recovery of Copying Costs.

The Licensee may charge a fee to cover costs of copying or printing portions of Licensed Materials for Authorized Users, including the costs associated with reproducing portions of the Licensed Materials for the creation of printed course packs. Such fees shall not constitute Commercial Use.

#### 3.6. Course Packs/Electronic Reserve.

The Licensee and Authorized Users may incorporate a reasonable limited portion of the Licensed Materials in printed Course Packs and Electronic Reserve collections for the use of Authorized Users in the course of instruction at the Licensee, but not for Commercial Use. Each such item shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source, listing title and author of the extract, title and author of the work, and the publisher. Course packs in non-electronic non-print perceptible form, such as audio or Braille, may also be offered to Authorized Users who, in the reasonable opinion of the Licensee, have physical or learning disabilities.

# 3.7. Electronic Learning Environments.

The Licensee and Authorized Users may incorporate limited parts of the Licensed Materials to be used in virtual and managed environments (including but not limited to virtual learning environments, managed learning environments, virtual research environments, library environments, and courseware technologies) hosted on a Secure Network. Each item shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source, listing title, author and copyright owner.

## 3.8. Use in Academic Research.

The Licensee and Authorized Users may incorporate limited parts of the Licensed Materials in printed or electronic form in assignments, portfolios, theses and dissertations, including reproductions of the Licensed Material for library deposit and other non-commercial uses.

## 3.9. Electronic Links.

The Licensor agrees to use reasonable efforts to comply with the Open URL standard. Licensee may provide electronic links to the Licensed Materials from Licensee's web page(s). The Licensor will assist the Licensee upon request in creating such links effectively, and will use the OpenURL standard for such links whenever feasible. Licensee may make changes in the appearance of such links and/or statements accompanying such links as reasonably requested by the Licensor.

## 3.10. Scholarly Sharing.

Authorized Users may transmit to a third party colleague in hard copy or electronically, a reasonable limited amount of the Licensed Materials for personal use or scholarly, educational, or scientific research or professional use but in no case for Commercial Use. In addition, Authorized Users have the right to use, with appropriate credit, figures, tables and excerpts from the Licensed Materials in Authorized User's own scientific, scholarly and educational works.

# 3.11. Interlibrary Loan.

The Licensee shall be permitted to supply to an academic, research or other non-commercial library (whether by post, fax or secure transmission, using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted immediately after printing), for the purposes of research or private study and not for Commercial Use, a reasonable limited portion of the Licensed Materials. Requests received from for-profit companies or directly from individuals may not be honored. Files transmitted in this manner must carry copyright notices. The Licensee agrees to fulfill interlibrary loan requests in compliance with Canadian Copyright Law and comparable principles of international copyright law.

# 3.12. Training and Marketing Materials.

The Licensee may display, download or print the Licensed Materials for the purpose of internal marketing or testing or for training Authorized Users or groups of Authorized Users.

#### 3.13. <u>Caching.</u>

The Licensee and Authorized Users may make such local digital copies of the Licensed Materials as are necessary to ensure efficient use by Authorized Users by appropriate browser or other software.

#### 3.14. Branding.

The Licensee may request that the product be branded with the name of the institution on the homepage of the product, or otherwise as agreed, in order to publicize the acquisition to the Authorized Users of the License.

#### 3.15. Walk-In Users

Walk-In Users may be given access to the Licensed Materials by Licensee, but only: (i) from terminals designated for walk-in users, which are physically located in Licensee's premises; and (ii) with a Licensee controlled IP address.

#### 3.16. <u>Indices.</u>

The Licensee may use the Licensed Materials in connection with the preparation of or access to integrated indices to the Licensed Materials, including author, article, abstract and keyword indices.

# 3.17 Persons with Perceptual Disabilities.

In regards to an authorized user with perceptual disabilities, the Licensee shall have the right to make a copy of the Licensed Materials in an alternate format in order to make it useable to this individual.

## 3.18 Text and Data Mining.

Authorized Users may use the Licensed Materials to perform and engage in text and/or data mining activities for academic research, scholarship, and other educational purposes and may utilize and share the results of text and/or data mining in their scholarly work and make the results available for use by others, so long as the purpose is not to create a product for use by third parties that would substitute for the Licensed Materials. Licensor will, upon receipt of written request, cooperate with Licensee and Authorized Users as reasonably necessary in making the Licensed Materials available in a manner and form most useful to the Authorized User.

#### 4. PROHIBITED USES

## 4.1. <u>Unauthorized Use.</u>

Except as otherwise allowed in this agreement, Licensee shall not knowingly permit anyone other than Authorized Users to use the Licensed Materials. Licensee may only use Licensed Materials as expressly permitted in Section 3 above. All other uses of the Licensed Materials are prohibited, including, but not limited to:

- (a) re-distribution, re-selling or sub-licensing in any manner including in connection with fee-for-service use or to other persons or entities except to Authorized Users (other than Walk-in Users);
- (b) supply or distribution of single or multiple copies in any form to anyone other than an Authorized User;
- (c) distribution of any part of the Licensed Materials on any electronic network, including without limitation, the Internet on the Worldwide Web, other than the Licensee's Secure Network; and
- (d) monetary reward (whether by Licensee or an Authorized User) by means of sale, transfer or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials or any part thereof without Licensor's prior explicit written permission. For the avoidance of doubt, bulk reproduction or distribution of electronic or print copies of Licensed Materials for sales/promotional purposes is specifically prohibited.

#### 4.2. <u>Modification of Licensed Materials.</u>

Neither Licensee nor its Authorized Users may modify, adapt, transform, translate or create any derivative work in any medium based on or including any materials in the Licensed Materials,

or otherwise use any such materials in a manner that would infringe the copyright or other proprietary rights therein. No copyright notices, trademark or proprietary notices, author attributions or other notices or disclaimers in the Licensed Materials included by Licensor, may be removed, obscured or modified in any way. Licensee shall post appropriate notices and take reasonable measures to ensure that Authorized Users are informed of the applicability of copyright law and have agreed to the restrictions in this License with respect to the reproduction, use and transmission of the Licensed Materials. In the event of violation of the terms and conditions of this License or of applicable copyright law, Licensor and Licensee agree to take immediate action to suspend access to the Licensed Materials by any Authorized User violating these restrictions on reproduction, use and transmission of the Licensed Materials and shall consider other restrictions on access to and retrieval of the Licensed Materials, including additional limitations on printing and downloading without prejudice to Licensor's rights and remedies.

#### 4.3. Commercial Purposes.

Licensee may not use the Licensed Materials for any Commercial Use or for any purpose other than those outlined in Section 3.

# 4.4. Automatic Searches.

Licensee shall not use any robots, spiders, crawlers or other automated downloading programs or devices to continuously and automatically search, index or retrieve any content accessed online under this License, except as permitted by this License. Licensee shall not reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble any software included in the Licensed Materials.

#### 5. LICENSOR RESPONSIBILITIES

# 5.1. Availability of Licensed Materials.

Upon the Effective Date of this License, Licensor shall make the Licensed Materials available to Licensee.

#### 5.2. Support.

During the Term of this License, Licensor will offer Licensee and Authorized Users support on weekdays, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. ET. Call 416-978-7074 or e-mail iter@utoronto.ca.

# 5.3. Completeness of Content.

Where applicable, Licensor shall use reasonable efforts to ensure that the online content is at least equivalent to print versions of the Licensed Materials, and represents a complete, faithful and timely replication of the print versions of such Licensed Materials where applicable. Licensor will cooperate with Licensee to identify and correct errors or omissions as required.

#### 5.4. Archiving.

Archival availability. The Licensor hereby grants to Licensee a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use the Licensed Materials that were accessible during the term of this License. The Licensor shall allow the Licensee to participate in the archiving of one complete copy of the Licensed Materials, and to use such archived Licensed Materials in the event the Licensor discontinues or suspends selling or licensing the Licensed Materials.

Such use shall be in accordance with the provisions of this License, which provisions shall survive any termination of this License. The means by which Licensee shall have access to such Licensed Materials shall be in a manner and form substantially equivalent to the means by which access is provided in this License.

## 5.5. Notification of Modifications of Licensed Materials.

The Licensee understands that from time to time the Licensed Materials may be added to, modified, or deleted by the Licensor and/or that portions of the Licensed Materials may migrate to other formats. Licensor shall give a sixty (60) day notice of any such changes to the Licensee.

## 5.6. Withdrawal of Licensed Materials.

The Licensor reserves the right at any time to withdraw from the Licensed Materials any item or part of an item for which it no longer retains the right to publish, or any item or part of an item for which the Licensor has reasonable grounds to believe it infringes copyright or is defamatory, or otherwise unlawful in nature from the Licensor's servers. The Licensor shall give written notice to the Licensee of such withdrawal. If the withdrawn material represents more than ten per cent (10%) of the Licensed Materials the Licensor shall make a pro rata refund of part of the Purchase Fee to the Licensee, taking into account the amount of material withdrawn.

#### 5.7. MARC Records.

Full MARC records will be provided at no additional cost. Updates to existing records will be provided on a regular basis and in a format that render them useful to the Licensee.

#### 6. LICENSEE'S RESPONSIBILITIES

# 6.1. Provision of Notice of License Terms to Authorized Users.

Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to provide Authorized Users with appropriate notice of the terms and conditions under which access to the Licensed Materials is granted under this License including, in particular, any limitations on access or use of the Licensed Materials as set forth in this License.

# 6.2. <u>Provision of Notice of Intellectual Property Right to Authorized</u> Users.

Licensee shall make reasonable efforts to provide Authorized Users with notice of any applicable intellectual property or other rights related to the Licensed Materials. Licensee shall

make reasonable efforts to prevent any infringement that comes to the attention of the Licensee, of any Intellectual Property or other rights of the Licensor in the Licensed Materials. Licensee shall promptly notify Licensor of any infringement that arises, and take appropriate steps to avoid its recurrence.

#### 6.3. Protection from Unauthorized Use.

Licensee shall use reasonable efforts to protect the Licensed Materials from any use that is not permitted under this License. Licensee shall use reasonable efforts to comply with the terms and conditions of this License by Authorized Users, and upon becoming aware of any unauthorized use or other breach, inform the Licensor in a timely manner and take reasonable and appropriate steps to ensure that such activity ceases and to prevent any future recurrence. Both parties agree to cooperate in good faith and provide sufficient exchange of information to prevent any further unauthorized use.

In the event of any substantial unauthorized use of the Licensed Materials by an Authorized User, (a) Licensor may terminate such Authorized User's access to the Licensed Materials, (b) Licensor may terminate the access of the Internet Protocol ("IP") address(es) from which such unauthorized use occurred limited to the specific IP address or subnet from which the use occurred, and/or (c) Licensee shall terminate such Authorized User's access to the Licensed Materials upon Licensor's request. Licensor shall take none of the steps described in this paragraph without first providing written notice to Licensee.

# 6.4. Maintaining Confidentiality of Access Passwords.

Where access to the Licensed Materials is to be controlled by use of passwords, Licensee shall issue log-on identification numbers and passwords to each Authorized User and use reasonable efforts to ensure that Authorized Users do not divulge their numbers and passwords to any third party.

## 7.1. General.

Licensor warrants that it has the right to license the rights granted under this License to use Licensed Materials, that it has obtained any and all necessary permissions from third parties to license the Licensed Materials, and to the best of its knowledge that use of the Licensed Materials by Authorized Users in accordance with the terms of this License shall not infringe the copyright of any third party.

# 7.2. <u>Limitations on Warranties.</u>

Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, punitive or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of data, business interruption, or loss of profits, arising out of the use of or the inability to use the Licensed Materials.

Licensor makes no representation or warranty, and expressly disclaims any liability with respect to the content of any Licensed Materials, including but not limited to errors or omissions contained therein, libel, infringement of rights of publicity, privacy, trademark rights, moral rights, or the disclosure of confidential information.

Except for the express warranties stated herein, the Licensed Materials are provided on an "as is" basis, and LICENSOR DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, CONDITIONS, OR REPRESENTATIONS (EXPRESS, IMPLIED, ORAL OR WRITTEN), RELATING TO THE LICENSED MATERIALS OR ANY PART THEREOF, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY AND ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF QUALITY, PERFORMANCE, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. Licensor makes no warranties respecting any harm that may be caused by the transmission of a computer virus or other such malicious computer program. Licensor further expressly disclaims any warranty or representation to Authorized Users, or to any third party.

#### 7.3. Indemnities.

Each party shall indemnify and hold the other harmless for any losses, claims, damages, awards, penalties, or injuries incurred by any third party, including reasonable attorney's fees, which arise from any alleged breach of such indemnifying party's representations and warranties made under this License, provided that the indemnifying party is promptly notified of any such claims. The indemnifying party shall have the sole right to defend such claims at its own expense. The other party shall provide, at the indemnifying party's expense, such assistance in investigating and defending such claims as the indemnifying party may reasonably request.

# 7.4. Term of Indemnity.

This indemnity shall survive the termination of this License for any reason. This indemnity shall not apply to any specific Licensed Materials if the Licensee has amended the Licensed Materials in any way not permitted by this License. The maximum liability of Licensor under this License, if any, for damages incurred by Licensee or any authorized user whether based in contract or tort, the total cost of the licensed product, for the life of the agreement, as listed in Schedule 1. NO LIMITATION OF LIABILITY SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS LICENSE IS APPLICABLE TO THIS INDEMNIFICATION.

#### 8. GENERAL

#### 8.1. Entire License.

This License constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes all prior communications, understandings and agreements relating to the subject matter hereof, whether oral or written.

# 8.2. Amendment.

No modification or claimed waiver of any provision of this License shall be valid except by written amendment signed by authorized representatives of Licensor and Licensee.

# 8.3. <u>Assignment & Transfer.</u>

Licensee may assign this License without the prior written consent of Licensor. Licensor may assign this License without the prior written consent of Licensee. The rights and obligations of this License shall bind and benefit any successors or assigns of the parties.

#### 8.4. Notices.

Any notices to be served on either of the parties by the other shall be sent by email or by prepaid recorded delivery or registered post to the address of the addressee as set out in this License or to such other address as notified by either party to the other as its address for service of notices. All such notices shall be deemed to have been received within 14 days of posting.

# 8.5. Force Majeure.

Neither party shall be liable in damages or have the right to terminate this License for any delay or default in performing hereunder if such delay or default is caused by conditions beyond its control including, but not limited to Acts of God, Government restrictions (including the denial or cancellation of any export or other necessary license), wars, terrorism, insurrections, strikes or other work stoppages, and/or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the party whose performance is affected.

#### 8.6. <u>Severability.</u>

The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License shall not affect the continuation or enforceability of the remainder of this License.

# 8.7. Waiver of Contractual Right.

Either party's waiver, or failure to require performance by the other, of any provision of this License will not affect its full right to require such performance at any subsequent time, or be taken or held to be a waiver of the provision itself.

# 8.9. <u>Dispute Resolution.</u>

If the parties disagree over an interpretation of this License or whether a party is in breach of any part of this License, the parties shall in good faith enter into negotiations to resolve the disagreement and discuss the feasibility of resolving the disagreement by mediation or other means short of litigation. The parties shall cooperate in good faith in pursuing mediation or such other means.

#### 9. TERM AND TERMINATION

# 9.1. Suspension of Access.

The Licensor reserves the right to temporarily suspend the Licensee's access to the Licensed Materials for substantial infringement of the rights holder's intellectual property rights in the Licensed Materials or for a breach of the terms of this License that threatens either the performance or security of the Server. Any account suspension by Licensor shall comply with the provisions laid out in Section 7.3 of this License. Immediately after suspending such access the Licensor shall issue a notice to the Licensee of the breach specifying the activity of the Licensee that caused the breach. The Licensor shall forthwith restore access to the Licensee upon receipt of notice that such activity has ceased and that the Licensee has made reasonable efforts to protect against recurrence of such activity.

# 9.2. <u>Breach of License.</u>

In the event that either party believes that the other materially has breached any obligations under this License, or if the Licensor believes that the Licensee has exceeded the scope of this License, such party shall notify the breaching party in writing. The breaching party shall have 30 days from the receipt of notice to cure the alleged breach and to notify the nonbreaching party in writing that cure has been effected. As between the parties, all rights with respect to trademarks, logos, society names and colophons are expressly and exclusively reserved by Licensor.


