Are You Still Eating Lettuce?

- Lettuce workers are paid only 1/2-cent for each head they harvest--an average of \$11.60 per day.
- 83 per cent of the lettuce farms do not provide toilets in the fields, forcing the workers to relieve themselves in the open and contaminating the crop.
- This spring, The U.S. Food And Drug Administration seized thousands of crates of lettuce bearing residues of Monitor 4 and Phosdrin, deadly organo-phosphate pesticides. Government officials estimate as many as 800 persons are killed and 80,000 injured by pesticides each year.
- The California Supreme Court found the lettuce companies guilty of "the ultimate form of favoritism" in making a deal with the Western Conference of Teamsters to destroy the United Farm Workers Union.

A boycott is an effective way to win justice for farm workers and safe food for consumers. Please don't eat grapes or lettuce unless you see the farm workers' union label--the Aztec eagle--right on the plastic wrapper.
