FDA Confirms that Contaminated Lettuce Was Shipped from Calif.

LOS ANGELES-Cesar Chavez' claim that poisoned lettuce from the out across the country took on new credence last week with the disclosure by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration that three shipments of lettuce contaminated with a pesticide in the nerve gas family apparently reached East Coast consumers before the Federal agency could destroy the lettuce.

The agency also said a fourth lot had been discovered but before it was seized, it was shipped to parts unknown. John R. Weatherwax. acting FDA director here, said the lettuce was tainted with residues of Monitor 4, a new pesticide produced by the Chevron Chemical Co.

Weatherwax said the shipments went to Buffalo and Rochester, N.Y., and Chelsea, Mass. in mid-January. Shipments usually contain several hundred cases, he said.
