Dear Mr. Noonan,

Farmworkers are the lowest paid workers in this country, earning as little as \$12 a day. Their children work in the fields, picking the food we eat. Farm workers have formed a union to end these conditions.

I support the United Farm Workers Union grape and lettuce boycott. I will not eat grapes or lettuce unless I see the UFW Aztec eagle on the label.

I am dismayed that A & P has refused to help the farmworkers. Stop & Shop, Finast, and Mencuccini's are cooperating with the boycott. But A & P, by selling boycotted grapes and lettuce, exploits poor farmworkers.

I strongly urge you to carry only United Farm Workers Union grapes and lettuce or none at all.
