Legal Department Memos

- (1) We are checking stores and have not found any Sun World and no Metzler. Kit Seawright, Vice-pres of Red Owl will write to them and will check her produce buyer to see if it is in their stores. H. Brooks Produce house says they haven't seen it for about two months. Both, they believe are out of season.

Erve Cell from Penny's said they would not advertize grapes for one week. I found out later that Country Club got the grapes that Penny's didn't sell that week. Red Owl said they would not advertize grapes because the season is over. Everyone speaks of the floods and their damage to the lettuce and the grower. I remind them that the Farm Worker suffers more than any one.

- (2) These people have agreed to call the growers on the potential unfair list.
