

ALRB employes take further steps to unionize; officers set

Agricultural Labor Relations Board employes took further steps this week to unionize, sources disclosed today.

Officers were chosen for the new union at a meeting Sunday in Los Angeles.

Monday, the group planned to file a unionization notice with the state Personnel Board.

ALRB employes throughout the state this week will be ask-

ed to ratify the union's bylaws.

Unionization was triggered by a statewide ALRB personnel shakeup by Harry Delizonna, the state agency's chief attorney.

Frank Fernandez, with the ALRB in Salinas, was selected to head the union.

Carlos Bowker of Heber, who was fired by Delizonna only two weeks ago, was named vice chairman of the union.

Other officers include Shirley Trevino, secretary; Karen Andres, treasurer; Bill Camp, in charge of internal communications; and Joan Anderson, public relations.

Trevino works out of the Salinas office. Andres and Camp are based in Sacramento, and Anderson is in Oxnard.

None of the union officers are with Delizonna's General Counsel's office.
