

Produce Growers to Fight Move to Switch Contracts

SALINAS, Calif., March 29 (AP) — Representatives of 200 Salinas and Imperial Valley produce growers agreed today to fight any move to switch their teamsters union contracts to Cesar Chavez's United Farm Workers Organizing Committee.

The switch was proposed last week in a top level agreement between the Interational Brotherhood of Teamsters and the American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations in an attempt to end months of jurisdictional conflict over farm workers organizing.

Daryl Arnold, president of the Free Marketing Council, said that "no teamsters official has said anything about rescinding the union's contracts." He added that he knew of no grower "who does not want his teamsters contract honored."
